



Art Studio on the Boulevard Class Descriptions

Children's Art Class (Instructor: Kim Barrigar - Harrell)

Tuesdays and Thursdays 5:30 pm – 7 pm, Saturdays 11:30 am – 1 pm

During weekly sessions, students are exposed to a variety of art styles including drawing, painting, pottery, mosaic, and other various art techniques depending on the age level.

The students will learn about the variations of art through multi-media exposure. They will also learn about fine art history as they create their own masterpieces.

The art classes include hand-on instruction, direction and critique. Students will learn basic drawing techniques needed for continuing art instruction. Art lesson fees include all art materials and supplies needed by the student.

Art Class Fees starting at \$105 per month – Materials Included

Beginning Pottery Wheel Throwing (Instructor: Jenae Duquette)

Tuesdays and Thursdays 11 am – 1 pm

Learn the graceful art of wheel thrown pottery. Students will learn how to center the clay on the wheel and how to make the basic forms of a cylinder and a bowl. Bisque firing and glazing will also be covered in this course.

Class Fees \$170 (8 Sessions) – Materials Included

Pottery Painting, Glazing and Slip Decorations (Instructor: Jenae Duquette)

Tuesdays 5 pm – 7 pm

Students will learn about the traditional decorating techniques of glazing and slip decorations as well as more creative decorating techniques like paintings, stencil, and collage.

Class Fees \$90 per month – Materials Included

Pottery – Thrown & Altered (Instructor: Kathy Thumm)

Thursdays 6 pm – 8 pm

Learn to make functional and creative pottery designs using wheel throwing and handbuilding techniques combined.

Class Fees \$60 per month – Materials Included

Pottery Class (Instructor: Kathy Thumm)

Saturdays 9:30 am – 11 am

Make functional pottery using wheel throwing, slab construction and drape molds. Make original designs to be fired and glazed for functional use.

Class Fees \$60 per month – Materials Included

Oil Painting (Instructor: Elizabeth Tumilty)

Saturdays 9:30 am – 11 am

This Oil Painting course is designed for adults 16 and older new to painting or those who have never tried oil paint before. The students taking this course will learn all of the basic techniques necessary to begin painting in oils, from invaluable understanding of color-mixing and blending to creating textural surface effects and stretching your own canvas. When the course is complete all the students will have produced at least one finished oil painting of their own ready for display in their home. Classes will offer step by step guidance for the beginner along with technical and creative advice and tips. Students will be guided through themed projects as they learn all aspects of oil painting techniques.

Class Fees \$90 per month – Materials List Provided

Drawing - Character Design and Cartooning (Instructor: Brit Burkhardt)

Saturdays 1 pm – 3 pm

Ages 16-Adult. Bring your fantasies into reality, learn how to correctly draw the human figure and then transform it with stylization and perspective. In this course you will learn facial & body exaggeration, with regards to fantasy art, comic books, and characteratures. You will also learn design principles that apply to the comic and fantasy art industry today.

Class Fees \$120 per month

Basic Drawing (Instructor: Bernard Conda)

Thursdays 7 pm – 8:30 pm

Ages 18+. A basic drawing course with emphasis on studying perspective, working with portraiture (heads and faces) and still life.

Class Fees \$100 (8 sessions)

Materials Needed – 11" x 14" sketchbook, pencils, kneaded eraser

Cartooning (Instructor: Bernard Conda)

Saturdays 4:30 pm – 5:30 pm

Ages 8-12+. Have fun and learn basic drawing skills through subject matter that children love: cartoon characters.

Class Fees \$80 (10 sessions)

Materials Needed – 11" x 14" sketchbook, pencils, kneaded eraser

Inside the Box – 3-D/Perspective Drawing (Instructor: Bernard Conda)

Thursdays 6 pm – 7:30 pm

Ages 18+. Study basic perspective and put that knowledge to "real world" use as we draw heads and faces- in 3-D!

Class Fees \$100 (8 sessions)

Materials Needed – 11" x 14" sketchbook, pencils, kneaded eraser

Private Art Classes

Scheduled on an Individual Basis with Selected Instructor

Concentrate on particular medium or projects with focused one-on-one instruction including portfolio preparation.
